The <u>University of Reading</u> has been at the forefront of UK higher education for nearly a century. It is a public university in Reading, Berkshire, England and was founded in 1892 as University College, Reading, a University of Oxford extension college. The institution received the power to grant its own degrees in 1926 by royal charter from King George V and was the only university to receive such a charter between the two world wars.





Reading has four major campuses. In the United Kingdom, the campuses on London Road and Whiteknights are based in the town of Reading itself, and Greenlands is based on the banks of the River Thames in Buckinghamshire. It also has a campus in Iskandar Puteri, Malaysia. The university has been arranged into 16 academic schools since 2016.



DEGREE AWARDING University of Reading



In order to be awarded the UoR Master Degree in Business Economics or International Accounting and Finance, students must acquire 180 UK university credits (= 90 ECTS)

After completing the Master programme in UoR, in order to complete the Master programme in UniTO, students are required to discuss a final dissertation (Thesis) under the supervision of a member of the UniTO academic staff. In case students choose in UoR Master programme the Dissertation/project option, they can discuss the same dissertation/final project in UniTO.



DEGREE AWARDING University of Turin



After completing the Master programme in UoR, in order to complete the Master programme in UniTO, students are required to discuss a final dissertation (Thesis) under the supervision of a member of the UniTO academic staff. In case students choose in UoR Master programme the Dissertation/project option, they can discuss the same dissertation/final project in UniTO.

The thesis/dissertation will be written and discussed in English through an oral examination, according to the Didactic regulations in force in UniTO.

The thesis/final project discussion has to take place within the last graduation session of academic year following the one in which they attended the master in UoR.






