



## **MERIT-BASED SCHOLARSHIPS REGULATION**

**SAA School of Management**, in the framework of the provisions adopted to support students enrolled in the 2019/2020 academic year, has provided that:

### **for the Master's Degree in BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION**

**N. 8 merit-based SCHOLARSHIPS** will be granted according to the criteria indicated below.

#### **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS and SCHOLARSHIP GRANTING**

- **N. 4** scholarships amounting to **€ 1.500,00** (one thousand five hundred/00) to the best students, enrolled in their **first year in the 2019/2020 academic year**, who have passed all the compulsory courses and have obtained the highest weighted average mark on the exams passed and registered by **31 July 2020** (excluding pass-or-fail examinations/ "idoneità")
- **N. 4** scholarships amounting to **€ 1.500,00** (one thousand five hundred/00) to the best students enrolled in their **second year in the academic year 2019/2020** who have passed all the compulsory courses and have obtained the highest weighted average mark on the exams passed and registered by **31 July 2020** (excluding pass-or-fail examinations/ "idoneità")

#### **ASSIGNMENT CRITERIA**

- The scholarships will be awarded **ex officio** (automatically), on the basis of the data available in the student's career and on the credits recognized by **31 July 2020 for students regularly enrolled during the 2019/2020 academic year.**
- Careers will be evaluated by committees set up for this specific purpose.
- Scholarships will be awarded to eligible students who have acquired the **highest weighted average** (excluding pass-or-fail examinations/ "idoneità").
- In the event of absolute equality between two or more students, the amount of the scholarship will be equally divided among those entitled.
- careers of students enrolled for more than two years ("fuori corso") **will not be taken into consideration**, except those students who have passed and registered all exams and should exclusively defend their thesis (graduating students);
- the students meeting the requirements above, **regularly enrolled in the 2019/2020 academic year and who have regularly paid tuition fees**, will be admitted to the evaluation process.

The above-mentioned scholarships **CANNOT** be combined with **scholarships awarded by EDISU** (even if you are applying for an EDISU scholarship) **or other scholarships provided either by public or private bodies.**
