

## **ART. 2.2 ACADEMIC PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS**



- ✓ To be duly enrolled at the University of Turin (UniTO) a.y. 2024/2025
  - ✓ Additional requirements are detailed in Annex I of the Erasmus+ for studies Call which has been complied by UniTO Schools and Departments







- ✓ Minimum 2 months (60 days) max 12 months
- ✓ Bilateral agreement conferming the stay (4,5,8,9 months)
- ✓ Ongoing student mobility from June 1st 2024 to September 30th 2025
  - √ Possible extention (after arriving abroad)

## **ART. 7.4 PAYMENT METHODS AND TIMING**



### FIRST PAYMENT

- 100% part A country contribution (during the first month)
- 70% part B (according to the economic requirement)
- 100% «Standard» Travel Grant (if applicable)

### SECOND PAYMENT

• 30% B + Travel Grant + Top-Up Travel Green if applicable





## **ART. 7.4 PAYMENT METHODS AND TIMING**



- Waiver / The student has to return the entire amount received if:
- > the student renounces to the Erasmus experience
- > the student stays less than 60 days abroad
- UniTO cancels the mobility due to a student's failure to comply with the obligations of the mobility contract they have signed
- The student has to return part of the amount received if :
- the student stays less than the period agreed by the Bilateral Agreement
- > the credits recognised by UniTO are less than 2 EU credits per month
- > the credits recognised by UniTO are less than 1 EU credit for dissertation research





## **ART. 7.4 PAYMENT METHODS AND TIMING**



#### All components of the Mobility contribution are:

- COMPATIBLE with other scholarships and/or grants from other funding bodies and/or scholarship
  providers, although the beneficiary (student) must check with them about the compatibility of
  Erasmus+ funding with any other funding claimed/received. The UNITA and Sezione UNITA e Mobilità
  Internazionale does not have this information, so students must contact the relevant organisations
  themselves;
- INCOMPATIBLE with additional EU funds granted for the same purpose, namely to support international Mobility.



## **ANNEX I CHOOSING DESTINATIONS - UG/PG**



Undergraduate students must apply for a destination where undergraduate places (UG) are available.

Postgraduate candidates must apply for a destination where postgraduate places (PG) are available.

Third year undergraduate students graduating (within October 2024) will be able to apply for a PG destination.



## ANNEX I LINGUISTIC REQUIREMENTS



Each destination has a specific Linguistic requirment. Please check it carefully in the Additional Requirements, there are 4 different cases:

- 1. NO LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS
- 2. SPECIFIC LANGUAGE LEVEL "prova di competenza linguistica da allegare alla candidatura. In assenza di certificazioni linguistiche, il Passaporto per l'Europa è fortemente consigliato prima della partenza". See points a, b, c, d, e, f.
- 3. **SPECIFIC LANGUAGE LEVEL** "Certificato/attestazione da allegare alla candidatura". See points b, c, f.

Point b: International Certificates (IELTS, DELF DELE, DFP, BEC).

**Point c**: Other language certificates or documentation suitable such as SAC, CLA and *Passaporto per l'Europa*.

**Point d: Transcript of Records (ToR)** relating to previous periods of mobility and proving that the candidate has passed language examinations.

**Point e**: Self-certification of a candidate being mothertongue or bilingual

**Point f:** Self-certification of being enrolled in a degree programme held in English.

Double degree programme candidates will have an interview in order to assess their language skills and suitability for the double degree programme.



#### **ART. 9 FIRST FINAL RANKING**



#### WINNERS OF THE 1st RANKING (VINCITORE):

Students will be ranked from the highest to the lowest depending on their scores and considering – if possible – the destinations they chose.

If you are a WINNER in the 1<sup>st</sup> ranking you cannot access to the 2<sup>nd</sup> ranking.

It is not possible to reject the destination won in the 1<sup>st</sup> ranking and request to be added in the second ranking.





# ART. 9 REALLOCATING STUDENTS (RIPESCAGGI)



Eligible students ("Stato Iscritto") not yet assigned will be transferred to destinations with places made available by students refusing or failing to accept their destination.

Those who still do not have a position could be reallocated in destinations left vacant following the Evaluation Committee procedures:

- 1. Reallocating by single ranking: Eligible candidates are placed in a single ranking based on their <u>highest score and destinations available</u> are assigned in descending order of score.
- 2. Reallocation by <u>language requisites</u>.



#### **ART. 9 SECOND FINAL RANKING**



The second final eligible candidate list is published approximately from mid-April 2024





## ART. 10 ACCEPTING/REFUSING THE MOBILITY



FIRST/SECOND RANKING: students must accept within 5 dates of the publication of the corresponding ranking.

The rankings will be published on the UNITO and SAA websites.

It is your DUTY to check.
